



DOCK OF ALL TRADES

Walker Bay has an affordable solution that literally extends your waterfront. Its AirDock works as a small-craft launch or swim platform. Set it up as a deck with a table and chairs, or fasten it to your boat's stern. It's even easy to tie multiple AirDocks together to create a larger space.

The dock might be inflatable, but it's surprisingly rigid, thanks to the company's AirWeb High-Pressure Construction. Seven layers of a heavy-duty polymer coat the fabric, which is joined inside by thousands of drop-stitch fibers. This elaborate web makes it possible to inflate to more than 6.5 psi or 0.45 bar. The result: a stable platform strong enough to hold several adults, kids and the family dog.

Underneath the deck, four Aqua-Loc ballast bags trap water and prevent the AirDock from sliding on the water's surface. Sixteen heavy-duty stainless steel D-rings attached in the same manner as towing rings on inflatable boats allow the dock to be secured to a yacht, anchor or other docks. The rope handle fastens to the stern of a pleasureboat when

moored. This portability makes it a great dock for swimming, sunbathing, diving, or even wakeboarding or waterskiing.

Unlike a traditional wood setup, the AirDock is comfortable, compact and stowable. Plus, all it takes to clean it is a simple wipe-down. It comes in two sizes: 30 and 60 square feet. The carrying bag makes it a cinch to pack away and stow when not in use. walkerbay.com
