DOCK WITH AIR, ANYWHERE ■

Walker Bay's new AirDock is much more than a giant inflatable air mattress. Using AirWeb High-Pressure Construction, the material is woven out of seven-layer polymer coated fabric that can be inflated to more than 6.5 PSI, creating a rigid platform. Stability is provided by the new Aqua-Loc system consisting of ballast bags on each corner that trap water and prevent the dock from tipping. Walker Bay says it's strong enough to support the whole family. Sixteen heavy duty stainless steel D-rings are attached in the same way as towing rings on inflatable boats to ensure added strength when tying up to a boat, or anchoring the dock. Deflated, the AirDock measures 36" x 20" x 13". Inflated, it's 8' x 8' and provides nearly a ton of buoyancy.
