

Inflatable AirDock

The AirDock™ from Walker Bay is able to provide an inflatable platform that can launch from a yacht at anchor and be used to clean the sides and waterline of a vessel, or used as a base for leisure activities such as diving, swimming or water skiing. Made using a heavy-duty seven-layer polymer coated fabric that is joined inside by thousands of drop-stitch fibres, much like an elaborate web, it is possible to inflate the dock to more than 6.5 PSI or 0.45 bar – thereby strong enough to support several adults at one time. Making use of the company's AirWeb™ High-Pressure Construction, underneath the deck are four ballast bags that trap water and stop the dock from sliding on the water. Walker Bay are confident that its stable, durable nature, in combination with features such as 16 heavy-duty stainless steel D-rings (similar to towing rings on inflatables) the dock can be securely attached to the stern of a yacht when moored, to provide a versatile platform. The AirDock is compact and stowable, requiring no maintenance other than simple cleaning.

It comes in two sizes: 30ft² and 60ft², and has its own custom carry bag for easy stowage or transportation.
